WATER FACILITIES

Stand pipe and direct pressure system of water works, installed in 1898 and owned by the town. Inexhaustible water supply from underground stream which feeds supply well at pumping station. Stand pipe of 94,000 galls. capacity, located one mile South West of business section, base of which is 170 ft. above same. Two Snider-Hughes pumps (8" X 12" X 8") capacity, 333 galls. each per minute, force water thro. city mains to stand pipe.

Eight miles of water pipes 4" to 10" diam. 89 double hydrants. Domestic pressure 85 lbs. in business section. Fire pressure 115 lbs. Daily consumption not known.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Volunteer, not organized. Fire alarm by telephone sounded by bell on Town Hall. One hose truck, 600 ft. 2 1/2" hose. Two hose carts with 500 ft. 2 1/2" hose each. Team from livery stable. 600 ft. 2 1/2" hose in reserve. Total amount of hose 2200 ft.

One mile of brick paved streets in good condition. Public lights electric. Policeman until midnight.
